- Additional Factors:
 - Students who are borderline to meeting admission requirements are encouraged to apply. Other factors considered for admission may include choice of degree program, rank in class, credit in advanced placement or honors courses, rigor of the high school curriculum, and grade trend

- Standardized testing scores, which must be sent directly to testing provider or on an official transcript
 - ACT minimum of 23, or new SAT of 1130
- High school transcript which shows graduation date GPA, and rank
 - If Core GPA is less than 2.5, ACT score must be 15 or higher
 - If Core GPA is less than 2.0, ACT score must be 23 or higher
- Application fee of \$20

example: English sub score is 18 or higher, the math sub score could be a 17 or 18 for the student to be considered for admissibility, if all other requirements are met)

Admission Process for Freshman

High School Seniors

Applicants may be offered admission to the freshman class based on six or more semesters of high school course work. However, the applicant must, by the time of enrollment, be graduated from an approved secondary school, with a minimum of sixteen high school units, including twelve of an academic nature. (Ordinarily this means four units in English, two in mathematics, two in natural science, two in social science, and two other units in academic areas.)

Application Procedures

In addition to the application form and fee, a student applying for freshman admission must submit:

- an official transcript of high school grades covering at least six semesters;
- official scores from either the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or the American College Test (ACT);

In some instances, letters of recommendation and a personal interview with a College representative may be requested. All prospective students are encouraged to visit the campus.

Spring Hill has a rolling admission. Once you apply, you will be considered for scholarships and will be alerted about acceptance/rejection within 10 days of turning in your application. **DO THE APPLICATION AS EARLY AS POSSIBLE!** It opens in August

- Requirements – BAMA employs a competitive admission process that includes reviewing and evaluating each application on an individual basis.
 - They will look at your ACT/SAT scores, High-school GPA, and your high-school course schedule
 - Example of a student who would be successful at Bama: 21 ACT with a 3.0
 - There is a \$40 application fee

- Deadline for scholarship consideration: December 15
 - Must fill out the scholarship application online
