



We have discovered a great opportunity for our students to earn college credit at little to no cost to them. Modernstates.org offers preparatory classes for CLEP testing, and if you pass the tests associated with the courses they will even provide you with a voucher that can be used to cover the costs of the test (which is normally \$87 per test attempt).

Registration is easy and free! You simply log into modernstates.org, scroll down and click on the “sign up” button. You will need the name of your school, first and last name, email address, and you will create a user name and password. Once registered you will enroll in the courses that you are interested in and once completed you will enroll to take the CLEP test with your voucher!!

You can take up to 8 courses through this program to receive 8 testing vouchers, so this is truly a great opportunity!

We will be holding a CLEP testing session at Pearl River High School on Thursday, January 10th, 2019 for students who would like to take the tests (either by purchasing a voucher or by completing the program through modernstates.org and earning a voucher).

A list of CLEP courses offered by Modernstates.org is listed on the back of this sheet, along with information on how the program works.

After reviewing the information, please see Mrs. Lee in room 116 to sign up for testing if you plan to test in January. We ask that students sign up for testing before Christmas break (by 12/21/18) so that we can know how many students we will need to accommodate.

HOW IT WORKS

1. Choose one or many free courses that interest you from great Universities listed on the modernstates.org website
2. Courses prepare you for widely accepted CLEP exams already accepted for credit by more than 2,900 colleges and universities.
3. Courses, textbooks and materials are free; all you need are internet access and your own desire to learn. Modernstates.org offers links to tutoring & mentoring.
4. Enroll at a college that grants credit for passing well established CLEP* exams.
5. Pass up to eight exams and potentially earn your “Freshman Year for Free.”
6. Learn more about CLEP; verify that colleges you may attend grant credit for passing scores at <https://clep.collegeboard.org/exams>
