Joshua Martin Building Technology Instructor Pearl River High School

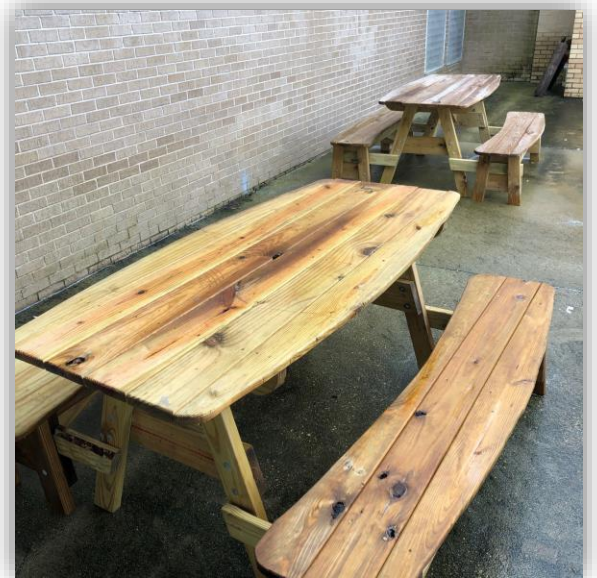
