Applicants must have 3.0 or higher GPA and submit a short essay on “What makes you an achiever” to the website below.

The applicant must have completed all of his/her public high school program (Grades 9-12) in the public schools of St. Tammany Parish. **The applicant must be planning to attend LSU next fall.** A 3.0 or higher GPA average in his/her four years of high school as well as a 23 or higher ACT composite score is required.

A 3.0 or higher GPA average in his/her four years of high school as well as a 22 or higher ACT composite score is required.
