Priority scholarships - Deadlines for specific colleges and university’s begin as early as **November, 2017**. To be considered for these priority scholarships, high school seniors must submit a completed admission application to the specific college or university on or before the deadline of their senior year in high school. Check the college/university website for specific deadlines.
